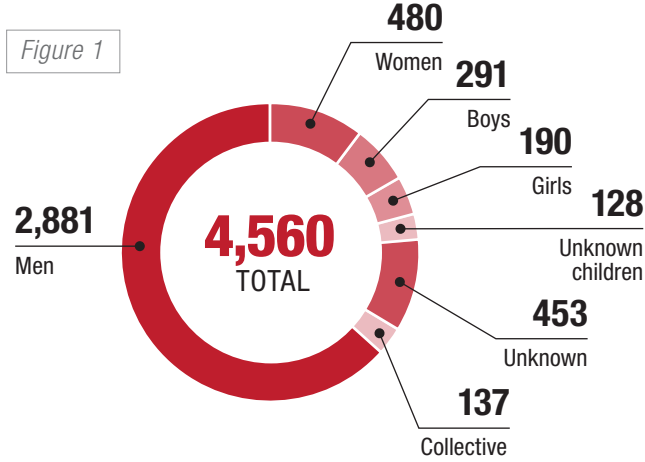


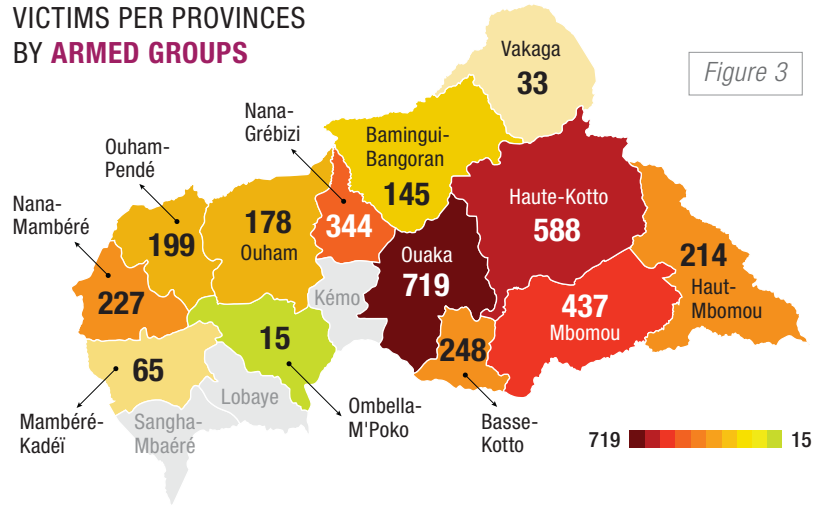

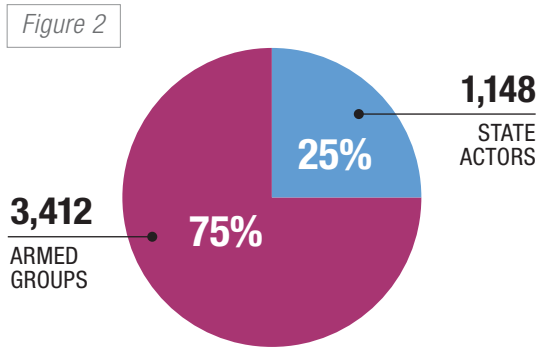
VICTIMS BY TYPE



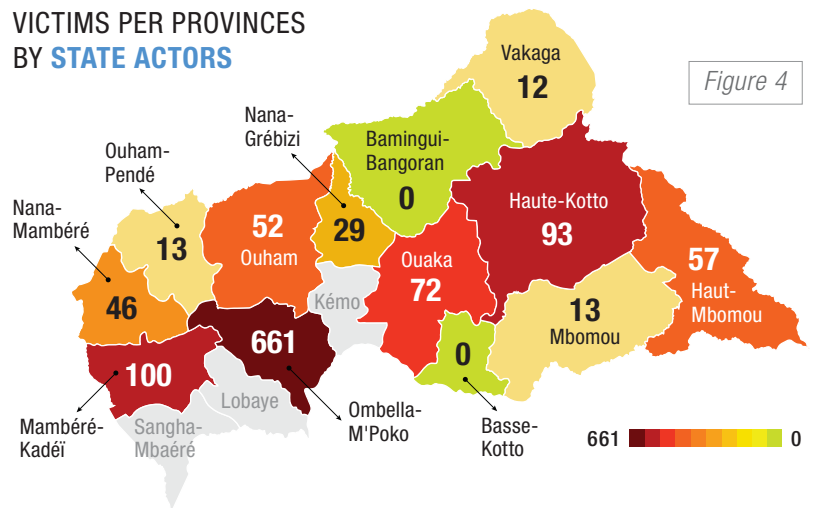
VICTIMS PER PROVINCES BY ARMED GROUPS



VICTIMS BY PERPETRATOR



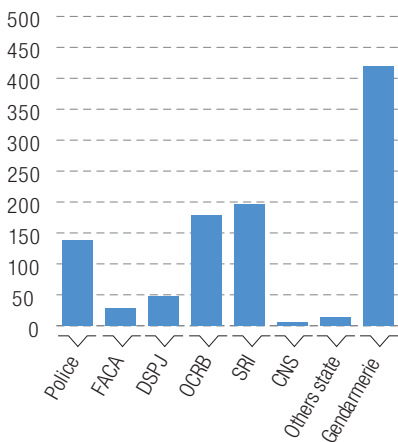
VICTIMS PER PROVINCES BY STATE ACTORS



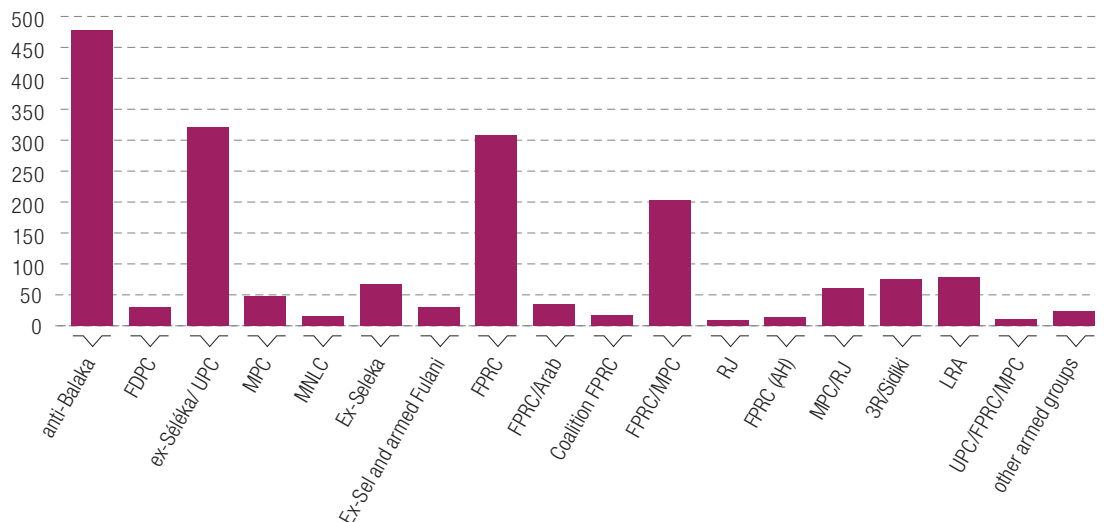
DISAGGREGATED DATA BY PERPETRATOR

EVOLUTION OF DOCUMENTED HUMAN RIGHTS VIOLATIONS BY PERPETRATOR PER MONTH

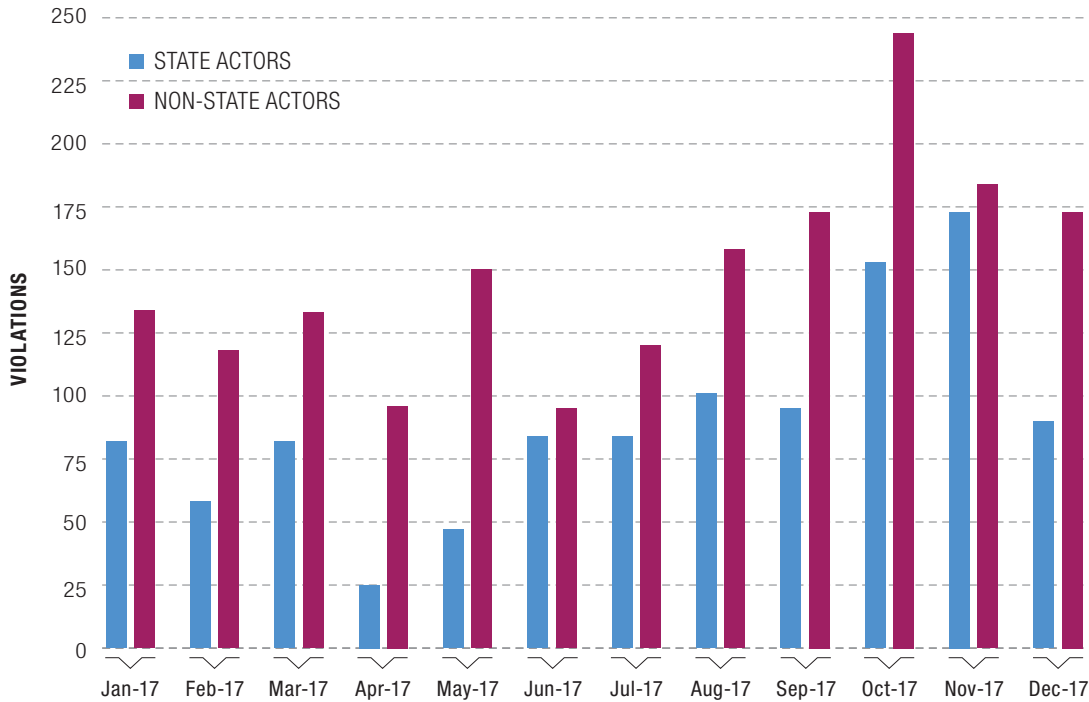

TOTAL STATE ACTORS VIOLATIONS

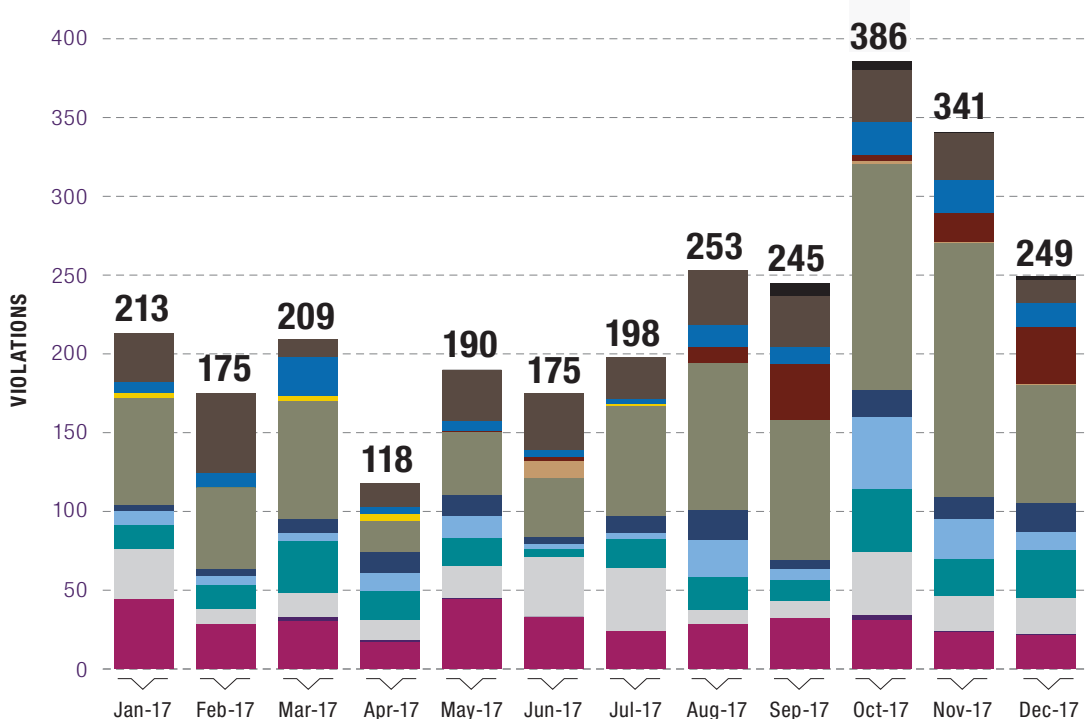
